

On the first of March two loads of nuclear waste will be on the road in the Netherlands. Destinations will be the reprocessing factories in La Hague (Fr) and Sellafield (UK). Holland is one of the few countries that restarted transporting nuclear waste. Untill now police allowed only one heavy garded transports on one day. Three transports already left, they planned at least an other 20. Activist succeeded in delaying these transports a couple of houres each time. On the first of March the goverment is planning to do two transports on one day. 1 leaving the from Dodewaard (near Arnhem) one leaving from Borselle (on the coast of Zeeland). Autorities have forbidden activist to protest near or on the transportroute.
